TRANSCRIPT EXPLANATION

Starting with school year 2019-2020, Tri-County transitioned from a four-quarter schedule to a trimester schedule. Due to this change the credit of a full-year course went from five credits to six. Two quarter electives that were 2.5 credits are now one trimester courses worth 2 credits.
